This program recognizes individuals pursuing a career in agriculture. Preference will be given to those students possessing leadership abilities and interest in the grain industry.

Scholarship Requirements

- 1. All applicants must possess a sincere interest in the grain industry.
- 2. All applicants must pursue a post high school education, i.e., college, vocational school, short course, etc.
- All applicants are required to complete and return the attached form no later than April 29, 2022, to Wisconsin Corn Foundation, N77W24707 Century Court, Lisbon, WI 53089. Applications may also be emailed to info@wicorn.org
- 4. Current high school seniors or those currently enrolled in post-secondary education are eligible to apply. Finalists will be selected from all applications.
- 5. Each of the finalists may be interviewed to determine the final award winner. Each finalist will be contacted in advance of scheduling.
- 6. The scholarship will be awarded after the Wisconsin Corn Foundation office has received confirmation of recipient's proof of enrollment.
