WCGA is governed by a board of directors and represents Wisconsin corn farmers in both Washington, D.C. as well as Madison, WI, on a myriad of issues affecting Wisconsin agriculture, corn production and rural life.

The WCGA board of directors includes nine farmers that derive a majority of their income from growing corn. They serve as at-large directors, representing corn farmers across the state.

WCGA is a member state of the National Corn Growers Association (NCGA); every member of WCGA is also a member of NCGA. What separates NCGA from other national agriculture associations is that NCGA activities and positions are guided and funded by their member states. Policies and positions are vetted through member states and corn farming "delegates" every year in March at NCGA's Corn Congress.
